

U.S. Cellular adds towers

YORK COUNTY, Maine — U.S. Cellular recently completed construction of five additional cell sites in York County to improve call quality for its customers.

One site in Wells will increase U.S. Cellular's coverage and network capacity around the southwestern section of the Town of Wells, the southeastern section of the Town of North Berwick, along Route 9 between Routes 4 and 109, and along Route 9B between Route 9 and Interstate 95. The second site in York will improve coverage on Route 1 between Cape Neddick and Ogunquit.

Two sites in Berwick will increase coverage and network capacity to the southern area of the Town of South Berwick and provide new coverage along Route 4 between South Berwick and North Berwick and to the town of Berwick and along Route 9 between Berwick and North Berwick. Lastly, a new site in South Berwick will provide new coverage to the western section of the Town of South Berwick.

All sites complement U.S. Cellular's statewide network of more than 270 towers.
